INTRODUCTION

Thank you for requesting an application pack for Eat Festivals 2017 food & drink events. We are now accepting bookings for pitches at the Burnham on Sea, Wellington, Taunton and Weston super Mare food and drink festivals.

The 2017 festivals are timed to maximise the opportunity of passing tourist trade – attracting them into the town centre. We typically aim to bring together around 100 producers, a top line-up of chefs, tractors, animals and entertainment to an anticipated crowd of 20000 visitors in Burnham on Sea and 10000 in Wellington. They are a glorious celebration of Southwest food and drink. The festivals provide plenty of activities to enable visitors to stay all day.

It is a great opportunity to sell and develop your business with thousands of interested visitors in a seaside town centre location.

Our festival promotes local producers and encourages long-lasting links to an engaged market of customers.

We go the extra mile to promote your local produce so that you don't have to.

SELECTION PROCESS

The festivals are available to anyone who produces or sells great tasting, sustainably and ethically produced food and drink. Space is limited so priority will be given to applications in the following order:

1. Those who have previously taken part in our events,
2. Proximity to host town, within 25 miles,
3. The produce offered allows us to create a well-balanced event, something we are passionate about, to avoid product saturation,
4. Any company supplying outstanding, great tasting, sustainably and ethically produced food and drink.

All producers must be able to document the production and traceability of their product in response to questions either from the Organiser or visitors to the festivals.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. All items displayed, sold and/or promoted at the festival must have been approved by, or made known to, the Organiser on this booking form and should comply with the selection criteria described above.
2. Full payment is required to secure your booking. An invoice will be issued, upon acceptance of your application, for the full amount owed. Settlement of this amount within the payment terms stated will secure your booking. If we do not receive payment within the payment terms stated on the invoice your booking may be cancelled. We will inform you of this before we cancel.
3. The pitch will be confirmed shortly before the Festival along with logistics, directions etc.
4. If the applicant cancels, fees are refundable on the following basis:
 - Cancelled 120 days before Festival – full refund
 - Cancelled 90 days before the Festival – 50% refund
 - Cancelled less than 90 days before the Festival – No refund**If the fees have not been paid the equivalent amounts under these refund terms will still be due.**
5. Traders must conduct their business in a manner that does not interfere with the interests of other traders, and not canvass for customers beyond the boundaries of their stand. Traders should not engage in activities which are deemed to be unethical or in breach of the law. The Organisers reserve the right to eject any trader without refund if a trader does not comply with these conditions.
6. A 'no smoking' and no vaping policy operates when tending a pitch.
7. In the interests of public safety, all traders must not dismantle their stand until after the event has closed. Traders to keep their stand appropriately dressed and maintained and all exhibits open to view and the stand adequately staffed continuously during the opening hours of the festival. Setting down of your stand early will result in any future event Pitch offers been redrawn.
8. The Trader shall be entitled to occupy the Pitch for the purpose of displaying only the Permitted Goods and Services for the duration of the Festival. The Trader shall not assign the benefit of the Contract for a Pitch or sub-let the whole or part of the Pitch, without the written consent of the Organiser.
9. Traders are responsible for their own goods at the Festival and no responsibility is accepted for loss, damage, or financial loss, due to abandonment or cancellation of the event due to factors beyond our control.
10. Stallholders are responsible for any accidents or injuries to the public caused by their products, display stands or their use of the space allocated to them, and must arrange their own Public Liability cover and have current Food Hygiene and Electrical/Gas Safety certificates as applicable. Copies of these should be available on the day of the event.
11. If a Trader, through fault of their reckless or careless actions, causes us expense, irrespective of intent we reserve the right to deduct fees, charge a levy or withdrawn a future Pitch offer.
